Breckenridge, one of Colorado's most popular resorts, has expert skiing up to 12,998 feet, on four mountains, named Peaks 7, 8, 9 and 10. Peak 8, with half of the resort's 2000+ skiable acres, is largely classified as expert terrain. Peak 10 is also mainly for experts. Most of the gentler slopes are on user-friendly Peak 9, which has almost half of the resort's lifts, and Peak 7. Breckenridge ranks as one of the country's highest resorts. Timberline at Breckenridge is roughly 11,500 feet. 40 % of the resort's terrain is open bowls.

Breckenridge was originally a mining town founded in 1859 and is the oldest continuously inhabited mountain town in Colorado. 2011 marks fifty years of skiing at Breckenridge Resort.



Cross Country Skiing: Breckenridge Nordic Skiing & Snowshoe Center, located on Ski Hill Road, offers a wide variety of cross-country and snowshoe terrain for leisure adventure or high-energy exploration. Trails wind in and through old growth spruce forests, with scenic overlooks on a newly expanded trail system on 1,300 acres in The New Nordic World on Peaks 6 & 7



Accommodations: Seven nights lodging at the Great Divide Lodge, a full-service slopeside hotel in a convenient central location, two-block walk from Main Street, while a mere 50 yards to the chairlifts of Peak 9 Base. With a stop on the town's free shuttle route and complimentary hotel shuttle service, all of Breckenridge is within easy access.

REFUND POLICY

- A trip participant is eligible for a full refund of monies paid if he/she cancels prior to **November 15, 2011**. Once ticketing occurs, the participant becomes fully liable for the full amount of the trip.
- If a participant cancels between **November 16, 2011 and November 30, 2011** it is that person's responsibility to find a replacement who will pay the full cost of the trip. (The replacement can come from the waiting list, provided one develops.) If a replacement is found, the participant is entitled to a full refund less any fees necessary to effect reservation and/or name changes and as long as the reservation can be changed to the name of the replacement per contractual obligations. If a replacement is not found, any and all penalties imposed by tour operators, transportation companies, lodging, or ski facilities, due to the withdrawal by the undersigned shall be the responsibility of the undersigned.
- If a participant cancels after **December 1, 2011** and cannot find a replacement, or fails to show up for the trip, then the participant is liable for the full amount of the trip. Once a trip is completed and all financial obligations are met, any refunds made by the tour operator, transportation companies, etc for that participant will be forwarded to the participant.
- Trip cancellation insurance is made available for every trip, and Snowbound SCI advises all participants purchase in the unlikely event that one may need to cancel.
- The undersigned participant hereby agrees that, in no event shall Snowbound Ski Club bear the financial responsibility of a cancellation.
