# SNOWBOUND SKI CLUB INTERNATIONAL

## Refund Policy

Following is the refund policy of Snowbound Ski Club International for all trips. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to discuss the matter with either your trip leader, or any member of the board.

- Once ticketing occurs, the participant becomes fully liable for the full amount of the trip.
- A trip participant is eligible for a full refund of monies paid if he/she cancels prior to:

Breckenridge: November 15, 2011

- If a participant cancels between (see dates below) it is that person's responsibility to find a replacement who will pay the full cost of the trip. (The replacement can come from the waiting list, provided one develops.) If a replacement is found, the participant is entitled to a full refund less any fees necessary to effect reservation and/or name changes and as long as the reservation can be changed to the name of the replacement per contractual obligations. If a replacement is not found, any and all penalties imposed by tour operators, transportation companies, lodging, or ski facilities, due to the withdrawal by the undersigned shall be the responsibility of the undersigned.

Breckenridge: November 16, 2011 - November 30, 2011

- If a participant cancels after (see date below) and cannot find a replacement, or fails to show up for the trip, then the participant is liable for the full amount of the trip. Once a trip is completed and all financial obligations are met, any refunds made by the tour operator, transportation companies, etc for that participant will be forwarded to the participant.

Breckenridge: December 1, 2011

- The participant agrees that in no event shall Snowbound Ski Club bear the financial responsibility of a cancellation

**Breckenridge**, one of Colorado's most popular resorts, has expert skiing up to 12,998 feet, on four mountains, named Peaks 7, 8, 9 and 10. Peak 8, with half of the resort's 2000+ skiable acres, is largely classified as expert terrain. Peak 10 is also mainly for experts. Most of the gentler slopes are on user-friendly Peak 9, which has almost half of the resort's lifts, and Peak 7. Breckenridge ranks as one of the country's highest resorts. Timberline at Breckenridge is roughly 11,500 feet. 40 % of the resort's terrain is open bowls.
